Reference Spreckels Community Services District Election of 1986 and Assessment for User Fees for secured parcels within the Spreckels Community Services District corresponding to District boundaries of the former County Service area No. 40. Spreckels Community Services District User Fees consist of \$15 per parcel in Zone 1 - Old Town. The maximum authorized assessment for parcels in Zone 2 - New Town is \$1476.52, though parcels have historically been assessed \$455.18, at discretion of the Board. Spreckels Community Services District is governed by the California Government code Section 61000-61936.
